System Scanner® End-of-Sale (EOS)

Internet Security Systems' (ISS) System Scanner® has reached its End-of-Sale (EOS), effective July 28, 2005 and ISS will begin the transition of its customers to Assuria Limited in order to place more focus on our core next-generation products. ISS recognizes that System Scanner is an important component in many of its customers' security solutions and has structured an agreement with Assuria that provides continued long-term development and support of the product beyond the ISS System Scanner End of Life (EOL).

Migration of System Scanner to Assuria Limited

ISS has partnered with Assuria to deliver a seamless migration path for our customers. All System Scanner customers upon expiration of their current maintenance will be transitioned to Assuria, who will provide ongoing customer support, product maintenance, enhancement and development of the System Scanner product and technology. Assuria has licensed the entire System Scanner source code, development tools and other files from ISS and will ensure continuity and compatibility of the agents and console. They have the product roadmap and are looking forward to continuing the development of the product.

As System Scanner customers come up for renewal, they will be referred to Assuria and will become customers of Assuria. ISS recommends that customers transition their System Scanner maintenance to Assuria at the end of their current maintenance period with ISS in order to continue to benefit from current and new platform support and an ongoing product development roadmap.
